AN INTERVIEW: Is it possible to crack with internship??



Deeksha Singh (NEET 2017, Rank 57 NEET 2017 1st Rank in Punjab State) BIG YES

- Q. Congratulations on securing a top rank in NEET 2017 Entrance exam. What is the secret of your success?
- A. Thank you so much. I believe continuous hard work, consistent efforts and GODs grace helped me to achieve this
- Q. Could you tell us something about yourself?
- A. I strongly believe Hard work can beat talent when talent doesnt work hard. I have done my BDS from SHAHEED KARTAR SINGH SARABHA DENTAL COLLEGE, LUDHIANA.
- Q. Who or what influenced you to take up dentistry as career?
- A. Like most others BDS was a chance not a choice. But with time I fell in love with my profession.
- Q. Were you an extraordinary student during your graduation years?
- A. NO, I was an average student. I was never a topper during my graduation. But I focused to get my concepts cleared.
- Q. What were your aggregate percentage marks for BDS?
- A. I scored an aggregate of 64.25%.
- Q. How did you prepare during your internship period?
- A. I started preparing from very beginning of my internship. But it took some time to be consistent enough. Then I joined **Dentacme**. They guided me well.
- Q. Was it your first attempt?
- A. Yes, it was my first attempt
- Q. When did you start serious preparation for this years entrance exam? What was your study strategy?
- A. I had small targets every day. I tried to finish them regulary. In the end they added up well.
- Q. Did you make any notes for helping your revision? Were they useful?
- A. I was not comfortable with making notes. But I had made some notes of important topics.
- Q. In your opinion, how much total time (in months) does a student require for preparing for this exam?
- A. At least 7-8 months with sincere efforts are enough.

- Q. How many hours did you study each day after college working hours? And how many hours you gave after completion of your internship?
- A. During internship i tried to sit for 7-8 hours daily. And after internship i increased the time to 14-15 hours
- Q. Did you have a timetable for preparation? Were you able to stick to it?
- A. I didnt have a strict time table. I just decided to achieve small targets daily.
- Q. What role did the internet play in your preparation (Facebook, Whatsapp etc)??
- A. I was part of **DENTACME** whatsapp group which gave all updates regarding the different exams and various important questions. TEAM **DENTACME** always helped me with my doubts
- Q. Did you ever doubt your ability to get selected in this entrance exam? If so, how did you overcome your fears?
- A. The preparatory phase is too long to have such thoughts, but fortunately my family and friends were a constant moral support. Our teachers at **Dentacme** were a source of inspiration.
- Q. Did you attend any classroom coaching? Was it useful? Do you think classroom coaching is essential for getting a good rank?
- A. Yes, I was part of **DENTACME** CLASSROOM PROGRAM. It was indeed useful.

- A. Clinical subjects were my priority but I also didnt take the non clinical subjects too lightly
- Q. How did you prepare for the image based questions?

- Q. What was your strategy for taking entrance exams?
- A. Keeping my calm and having faith in my hardwork.
- Q. Which specialty are you interested in choosing and why?
- A. I like all the clinical braches of dentistry.
- Q. What is your advice to future aspirants?
- A. I want to wish all the future aspirants all the very best. Rest when you get tired but dont quit.

AN INTERVIEW



Dr Anirban Raha (*Rank 129 NEET Dec 2016*)

- Q. Congratulations on securing a top rank in NEET 2017 MDS Entrance exam. What is the secret of your success?
- A. Thank u. The secret of my success-Patience, Hardwork and Faith.
- Q. Could you tell us something about your self?
- A. I am from New Alipore, Kolkata. I have done my schooling from South Point School. I love reading, listening to music and am a huge sports fan whether it be cricket, soccer or tennis.
- Q. From which college did you finish your BDS graduation?
- A. I did my BDS from Guru Nanak Institute of Dental Sciences and Research, Kolkata (2009-2014).
- Q. What are your aggregate percentage marks in BDS?
- A. My aggregate percentage marks in BDS is 64.
- Q. Were you an extra ordinary student during your BDS years?
- A. No I was not an extraordinary student. Just an average sincere student. I guess.
- Q. How did you prepare during your internship period?
- A. During internship it is difficult to find time and balance between work and studies. I cant say that I managed to give full effort in my studies during my internship but I was lucky enough to get a good rank in COMEDK(220) and KLE(69). However my rank in AIPG was much worse(1232). This was in 2015. After this I made it my goal to crack AIPG.
- Q. What ranks did you obtain in your previous attempts? What changes did you make to your preparation after your last attempt?
- A. After 2015, in 2016 my rank in AIPG was 419. I was quite disappointed. The paper was quite difficult but its really no excuse. I also gave COMEDK where my rank was 226 and my WBPG rank was 34. But the disappointment of AIPG was very overwhelming so I decided to have one last attempt. That means back to the basics and starting from scratch once again.
- Q. When did you start serious preparation for this years entrance exam?
- A. I started my preparation for this year back in March, 2016. My strategy and objective for this year was that I wanted to be very thorough with everything I was doing. That means a lot of revisions and going through topics that I hadnt covered well enough before. I didnt want to leave any stone unturned.
- Q. Did you make any notes for helping with your revision? Were they useful?
- A. I am not very good in making notes but I must say I did make a copy where I used to note down important dates and names of persons. It was really helpful for me during revisions.
- Q. How many hours did you study each day? In your opinion how much time does a student require for preparing for this exam?
- A. I never planned how many hours I need to study. I believe you have to study as long as you need to finish your subjects and stay on schedule. You yourself can only say how much time you need to put in. It differs from person to person. But in general 10-12 hours per day is good enough. Atleast it was for me.

- Q. Did you have time table for preparation? Were you able to stick to it?
- A. You always have to have a fixed schedule for your preparation and you also need to stick to it. Its not always possible but atleast you need to try hard to keep on time.
- Q. What role did internet (Facebook, Whatsapp etc) play in your preparation?
- A. In todays preparation, Facebook and Whatsapp have become very important. People post their doubts and queries which are usually answered by other people. So if you dont know the answer to a question or maybe you have a doubt, it gets cleared in that way. And also you tend to remember these things really well. So it was very helpful for me.
- Q. Did you ever doubt your ability to get selected in this entrance exam? If so, how did you overcome your fears?
- A. PG entrance examinations are quite tough. You can never surely know whats gonna happen. It always plays on your mind. But I think you always need to have a positive attitude during your preparation. You need to believe that you can do it which is the single biggest motivation for a person.
- Q. Did you attend any classroom coaching? Was it useful? Do you think classroom coaching is essential for getting a good rank?
- A. I didnt do any classroom coaching myself. But if somebody wants to, they can definitely do. Certainly wont harm.
- Q. Did you attend any test series? If so, did you find it useful?
- A. I did attend Dentacme online test series. Weekly tests on various subjects and also mock tests helped me to assess myself really well. It gave me confidence and also showed me the areas where I needed to work on.
- Q. What were the subjects you focused upon?
- A. You need to do all the subjects very well. Even though I gave special emphasis on clinical subjects, but with the current pattern of NEET I think everyone should give equal weightage to both basic and clinical subjects.
- Q. Which books did you stressed most for preparation?
- A. For books I stressed on Dental Pulse, Dentest, Jitendra Sharan, AIIMS-25 for AIIMS papers and Neeraj Wadhawan for AIPG papers. There were a lot of other books also but these are the ones I was really thorough with.
- Q. Is there anything specific to keep in mind while preparing for NEET?
- A. For NEET you really need to be thorough with everything you are studying whether its explanations or synopsis because questions can come from anywhere.
- Q. How did you prepare for the image based questions?
- A. For image based questions I used to go through pages of standard textbooks. Image Based Questions of Dentacme Test Series proved to be very beneficial for me.
- Q. What was your strategy in last week before taking NEET exam?
- A. My last week strategy before NEET was to stay relaxed as much as I could, revise a little and not get too much worked up. You also need to sleep well.
- Q. What is your advice to future aspirants?
- A. My advice for future aspirants will be- Dream big, work hard and always believe in yourself. And remember anything seems impossible until its actually been done. Wish you guys all the very best!!

Dr Jannis Arora Rank 4, PGI, 3rd Rank in Punjab State, Rank 111 NEET Dec 2016: BIG YES

- Q. Congratulations on securing a top rank in NEET MDS Entrance exam. What is the secret of your success?
- A. My secret of success was persistent determination, a clear mind set and a passion to achieve what I want.
- Q. Could you tell us something about yourself?
- A. I am from Jagraon, Punjab . I did my BDS from Punjab govt. dental college, Amritsar.
- Q. When did you finish your BDS graduation and in which year?
- A. June 2015
- Q. What are your aggregate percentage marks in BDS?
- A 65.6%
- Q. How did you prepare during your internship period?
- A. I dint study much during my internship. I started studying seriously after college in july 2015.
- Q. What ranks did you obtain in your previous attempts?
- A. AIIMS Nov 2015- 170 rank , PGI Nov2015 -130 rank, AIIMS Nov2016-127rank , PGI Nov2016- 4th rank
- Q. What changes did you make to your preparation after your last attempt?
- A. I dint make much changes but I focused upon limited number of books so that I could revise more.
- Q. When did you start serious preparation for this years entrance exam?
- A. Mid of may 2016
- Q. What was your study strategy?
- A. I used to make a schedule each day keeping in mind daily time available for study and duration left before exams. I used to study subject wise ,one subject at a time and did related subjects together. I used to refer textbooks (either standard book or any other you read) for confusing topics. Revision is very important. So its not about number of books you read, its about number of times you read one book.
- Q. Did you make any notes for helping with your revision? Were they useful?
- A. Yes, I did make notes. Since syllabus is vast, making notes helps.
- Q. How many hours did you study each day? In your opinion how much time does a student require for preparing for this exam?
- A. I used to give 7-8 hours/day during initial months of preparation. During last 2 months I used to put in approximately 10hrs/day or may b more. Quality of study is way more important than quantity. You can spend 12hrs reading with your phone by your side, it is equivalent of 6 hrs of quality study. So try to give more time to quality study. There will be times when you study like

- 12 hrs/day and one day 3 hrs/day. Dont get disappointed. Just keep going.
- Q. Did you have time table for preparation? Were you able to stick to it?
- A. Yes and I was able to follow.
- Q. What role did internet play in your preparation?
- A. I was the part of **Dentacme** watsapp discussion group. It was very useful for the queries. Also I used to go through slides for image based questions. But books are enough if u dont hav an access to internet.


